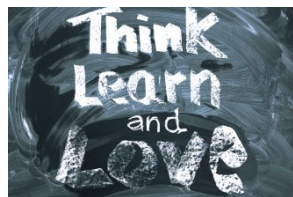


1. In the interest of saving postage expense, we will NOT be sending out mid-year contribution statements as we have in previous years. If you would like a mid-year statement, please contact the church office.
