Locally, each year Berks Connections/Pretrial Services and Opportunity House's [2nd Street Learning Center](#) are in need of gifts. BCPS hosts a Christmas party for the children of incarcerated parents. Gifts are distributed at the party. Opportunity House distributes gifts to the children at the learning center.

How can we help? An easy way to participate is to buy a gift for a less fortunate child in one of these programs. We hope to divide the gifts giving half to each group.
